House vote on FY24 Interior Appropriations

- Amendments to eliminate NEA & NEH
- Next step the Senate
  - Reconciling differences
    - House \$186 million
    - Senate \$207 million

# FY25 Budget

- Starts with Governor's Budget January
- Moves to Legislature
  - House
  - Senate
  - Conference Committee
- Sent to Governor for signature



# FY25 Budget

- FY24 (current budget)
  - \$25M Mass Cultural Council line item
    - \$3.56 per capita\*
- Campaign for Five
  - \$35M Mass Cultural Council line item
    - \$5 per capita\*
