FEDERAL FUNDING

- The First FY24 Appropriations bill is expected to pass today
- Includes Department of Interior:
 - National Endowment for the Arts \$207M
 - National Endowment for the Humanities \$207M
 - \$5M for Creative Arts Therapies at the Department of **Veterans Affairs Administration**
 - \$5M for Partnerships at the Department of Veterans **Affairs Administration**



GOVERNOR'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BOND BILL

MASS LEADS

- \$50M for Cultural Facilities Fund (CFF)
- Live Theater Tax Credit program
 - Five-year pilot
 - \$5M annual cap
- \$40M for Tourism asset improvements (Destination Development Grants)
- \$8M for Historic Preservation Grants
- \$150M for Library Construction Grants



GOVERNOR'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BOND BILL

MASS LEADS

- \$35 M for Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI) grants to help disadvantaged and underserved businesses access capital.
- \$25M for Small Business Technology Grants to help early-stage companies commercialize new and innovative technologies developed in Massachusetts.
- \$10M for Biz-M-Power matching grants small business capital-related needs

- Goes to the Governor to Sign


BOND BILLS ARE NOT SURE BETS



GOVERNOR'S SUPPORT FOR CREATIVE SECTOR

ADDITIONAL ACTIONS

- Executive Order to establish the Governor's Advisory Committee on Cultural **Policy Development**
- Community One Stop grants (OED program) will give additional prioritization to applications focused on/in cultural districts.
- Artist in Residence and Poet Laureate The Governor will designate an Artist in **Residence and Poet Laureate for the Commonwealth.**
- Mass Office of Tourism and Travel will produce an annual Governor's **Conference on Travel and Tourism (April 2, 2024)**



HOUSING BOND BILL

- Moved out of Committee
- Now with Bonding Committee



CREATIVE SECTOR AGENDA

- 4 Bills are moving forward
- Working to get bill language included in larger pieces of legislation

FY25 BUDGET

- Ways and Means Committee starting hearings
